*Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Psychology (child development, counseling), Criminal Justice, Pastoral Counseling, Rehabilitation Counseling, Community Mental Health, Sociology, Education with a certificate in Special Education or Nursing with a Registered Nurse License **AND** a commitment to attend the post graduate Service Coordination Certificate course within the first year of hire.*
